	It was noted that 2021 had been a challenging year owing to Covid. Ellingham Community Trust kept people in touch using community contacts, and provided a Financial Assistance Scheme to support the community. The Trustees provided support to the community. In August 2020 the Financial Assistance Scheme was wound up when Covid restrictions eased. Ellingham Community Trust continued to operate the Solid Fuel Scheme, Domestic Appliance Sscheme and Personal Development Scheme. The schemes were reviewed and the Domestic Appliance Scheme was refocused and relaunched as the Green Scheme to direct expenditure towards greener appliances. Ellingham Community Trust remained commit to funding main applications from Ellingham Village Hall (which is now built) and St Maurice's Church (which is getting underway). JG noted updates from both projects at the end of the last meeting. The minutes of the previous AGM were approved by JG and seconded by LF.

	LF provided the Trustees with further detail on some of the figures within the report. LF reported that £332 related to the final RHI write down. LF reminded the Trustees the RHI funds related to the boiler installation at Ellingham School with RHI payments originally collected by the Trust. Owing to the changes in RHI percentages, the Trustees agreed to stop collecting the RHI payments from the school to provide the school with additional funds, this has been written off in the Accounts over a ten year period. LF noted that Ellingham School is listed as a debtor for Accounts purposes. LF noted that £305 Other Expenditure relates to Insurance. LF noted that the		
	Creditor listed related to accountants fees.		



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	LF asked for questions. A query was raised about the Windfarm paying for admin costs. In response, LF noted that the Windfarm reimburses all admin fees including the Parish Magazine printing, Insurance and Clerk's salary. LF noted that the Windfarm are supportive to Ellingham Community Trust as the Trustees use the funds to benefit the community. LF noted that the Trustees have previously budgeted for 2% interest from the Windfarm, but owing to external factors, the Trust now receive 11% interest. LF	
	explained that the funds received by the Trust were fixed as £ per megawatt and inflated with RPI. LF noted that the income to the Trust will increase next year. LF noted that Ellingham Community Trust owes a debt of gratitude to the initial Trustees who set up the initial Trust.
