1. Approval of Minutes:

3. Treasurer's Report

a. Treasurer's Reports

Louis Fell delivered the Treasurer's report.

4. Applications

a. Update: Ellingham Village Hall & St Maurice's Church.

David Milne reported that Ellingham Village Hall Lottery application has been approved. The Trustees noted that Ellingham Village Hall are still trying the get a loan via Northumberland County Council. The Trustees noted their recognition of the ongoing fundraising.

David Milne reported that St Maurice's Church were planning to appoint a central heating contractor by the end of February, but this have not occurred owing to an unknown setback. As a result of this, St Maurice's Church don't need the first grant payment until after March. The Trustees noted this and will receive a report at the next meeting.

George Unwin noted that 3 applications were received since the last meeting. The scheme continues to be popular.
